

Yahweh's All Natural Farm & Garden Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) Program 2017-18

What is Community Supported Agriculture?

Community Supported Agriculture is much different than going to the local grocery and buying your vegetables. It is a direct partnership between you (the consumer) and our farm (Saul and Diana Padilla). CSA members pay in advance for a share of the upcoming harvest and are ensured high-quality local produce; the farm is ensured a consistent market. Produce is harvested directly from our fertile and USDA-certified organic vegetable fields, located south of Harlingen, just off Rangerville Road. Immediately after harvest we deliver "CSA shares (produce)" to our members' homes and offices in Harlingen and San Benito, and to community pick-up locations in Brownsville, Harlingen, McAllen and Weslaco.

What does a CSA Membership Include?

- ❖ Your choice of a weekly or every-other-week delivery of seasonal USDA-certified organic vegetables, fruits and herbs bursting with flavor and freshly harvested from our fields.
- Invitations to Yahweh's All Natural Farm and Garden member events, such as our annual Spring and Fall farm open house so you can see where your food is grown and meet the people who produce it.
- The option to add to your CSA share free-range eggs, goat, lamb and fruit when available.
- ❖ In addition, our website and Facebook page will share weekly a photo and a recipe with details about how to handle and store your produce. We will also share news from the farm and cover events and happenings in the local Harlingen food and farming community.
- ❖ You will also have access to our online recipe database, cooking and storage tips, and photos.
- You are invited to join us on Facebook.

What's in a CSA Box?

We grow over 40 different types of vegetables and herbs, and each week, members receive a "share" box filled with a variety of organically grown vegetables, fruits and herbs. The number of vegetables in your share will vary between 6 to 8. All of the vegetables come from Yahweh's All Natural Farm and Garden directly and are USDA-certified organic. We select all of the vegetable varieties we grow based upon flavor, fruit abundance and adaptability. The contents of each week's box can be found on our home page, and recipes using those items are included in our weekly Facebook posts. You can see photos of our recent CSA boxes.

Yahweh's All Natural Farm & Garden Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) Program 2017-2018 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The member agrees to pick up weekly produce shares at the agreed upon time and location. If the member does not pick up produce or does not designate another person to do so, Yahweh's All Natural Farm and Garden may donate the produce. Refunds will not be issued and pick-ups cannot be made up, unless it is the fault of Yahweh. Members who choose to split a share must do so on their own; Yahweh's must receive a single payment and will make a single distribution. Member shares must be picked up at the specified location for the entire season.
- 2. The member will include in their payment a \$10.00 deposit for one insulated bag. Shares will be delivered in a box with the bag inside; members will remove the bag containing the vegetables and will leave the box at the pick-up location so that we can re-use them. Insulated bags must be returned at the end of the season to receive a refund of the deposit.
- 3. The member agrees to share in the risk of farming, including poor harvests due to unfavorable weather or pests; refunds will not be issued under circumstances over which Yahweh has no control.
- 4. The member understands that on occasion, Yahweh may add produce from another Certified Organic Farmer.
- 5. The member understands that the farmers, Saul and Diana, pledge to do their best to provide the fruit, vegetables, and herbs they produce at the times they estimate and that they are of the highest quality possible. However, as a shareholder in both the bounty and the risk, the member understands that nature ultimately decides what they will receive and when they will receive it. In the unlikely event of dissolution of the CSA by the operators, refunds will be issued on prorated basis within 60 days of the date of dissolution.
- 6. No refunds will be issued after 30 days of membership.
- 7. Member loses their share after missing three consecutive pick-ups.
- 8. Members may transfer ownership of their share with prior notification to Yahweh, provided that the new owner uses the same pickup location as the previous one. Any prospective purchaser of the share must fill out the application and sign a copy of the agreement, before transfer is finalized. Financial agreement for sale of share is the holder's responsibility.
- 9. Members shares will not be delivered unless Yahweh has received payment for the shares.
